

Information Sheet: Jordans Mill



A food heritage attraction situated on the banks of the river Ivel

Tucked away on the River Ivel, the last working flour mill in Bedfordshire has been running for over 150 years. Although no longer used to mill flour this fine example of Victorian technology is preserved for future generations to enjoy. Guided Mill Tours are available from Tuesday to Sunday at 11.30am and 2.30pm. Outside of these hours self-guided tours are available.

Visitors can enjoy the beautiful Mill gardens and the wildlife and tranquillity of the nearby meadow and woodland. If you're hungry visit the Riverside Café where you can enjoy freshly prepared food and drink overlooking the stunning views of the River Ivel. Also on site is Jordans Mill Shop where you can pick up locally produced food and craft beers.
