

Information Sheet: Rushmere Country Park



One of Greensand Country's most popular destinations and great place to discover nature and enjoy outdoor leisure pursuits over 400 acres of beautiful woodland, heathland and lakes.

Rushmere Country Park is a place for all the family to enjoy nature and the great outdoors. There really is something for everyone, with amazing views and family friendly events. Bring a picnic and spend the day exploring all the park has to offer. Or experience the quality of the local produce at the Tree Tops Café, located in the Visitor Centre. Outside the Visitor Centre is The Deck, the perfect place to enjoy splendid views over Heron Valley and to spot herons nesting in spring.

The paths around the park offer some of the best walking routes in Greensand Country. The Sculpture Trail is ideal for families all year round. Discover the fairy doors, play on the wooden sculptures and have a photo taken in the Giant's Chair. Cyclists can also enjoy additional access to cycling trails with the purchase of a Greensand Cycle Pass.

Dogs and horses are also welcome, with designated dog walking areas within the park and a Dog Fun Area located at the back of the main car park. Horse riders can enjoy dedicated parking for their horse boxes and the park can be accessed on horseback along the public bridleway from Great Brickhill. A Greensand Horse Riding Pass is also available for those wishing to access a network of horse-riding trails.
