

Summerfields' Miniature Railways

A great day out for all the family. Visit during a public running day and enjoy watching and riding on miniature trains!

The Summerfields Railways have been built by the Bedford Model Engineering Society as a place for members to run their locomotives. On certain days of the year the railway is open to the public to learn about the hobby and take a trip on a steam or diesel miniature train. There's space for a picnic and a purpose-built log cabin will serve a Station Buffet.

On public running days, the first train departs at 10:30 from Haynes End and the last train of the day departs at 15:45. A return ticket costs £2.00 per person but children under the age of two travel free.
