Woburn Abbey & Gardens



There is so much to discover at Woburn Abbey, with colourful gardens, amazing scenery and 3,000 acres of deer park to explore.

Woburn Abbey has been the Russell family home since the early 17th century. It first opened to the public in 1955 and welcomes visitors from all over the globe. It is a wonderful day out with so much to discover and a particular favourite of walkers, with many public footpaths journeying through amazing scenery. The Abbey and Gardens also provide a magnificent backdrop for a myriad of events throughout the year, including charity challenges and the annual Woburn Abbey Garden Show.

Explore over 28 acres of gardens, inspired by the designs of landscape gardener, Humphry Repton: everything from flower beds blooming with colour around neat, green lawns through to ponds and woodland. With so much to discover, visitors return throughout the year to experience the changing landscape through the seasons.

Woburn Abbey Deer Park covers 3,000 acres and is home to nine species of deer making it one of the largest private conservation parks in Europe. As well as the famous Pére David's Deer, visitors should keep an eye out for Sika, Axis and Barasingha, as well as the rare and shy Rusa Deer. You may also see small Muntjac and Chinese Water Deer roaming individually.
