



Woburn Safari Park



Part of the Woburn Estate,
Woburn Safari Park is an awardwinning attraction with over
1,000 wild animals including lions,
tigers and bears!

A family day out at Woburn Safari Park includes a road safari, foot safari and a full programme of keeper talks and demonstrations with the animals. There's also a Go Ape zip-wire course which will take two to three hours (and it's recommended to book in advance).

The road safari features four distinct zones: Northern Plains with pastures of bison, zebra and wild horses; Savannah Grasslands is home to a herd of Ankole cattle, antelope, rhino and ostriches; Kingdom of the Carnivores is the domain of tigers, wolves, bears and lions; and the Giraffe Junction is home to the critically endangered Rothschild's Giraffe.

The Foot Safari takes in many smaller animals including colourful macaws and cockatoos, penguins, lemurs, sea lions, giant tortoises, pygmy goats and alpaca. Talks and demonstrations occur throughout the day and there are also opportunities to learn about the park's animal conservation work.

There are plenty of activities to keep you busy at Woburn Safari Park! The Great Woburn Railway takes visitors on a gentle scenic tour of the Foot Safari area; the Mammoth Play Ark is a gigantic indoor soft play activity area; meanwhile pedal boat swans can be ridden for no extra cost and several outdoor play areas are dotted throughout the park.

Enjoy lunch at the Safari Restaurant, the Lookout Café or at the 2x2 Restaurant adjacent to the indoor soft play centre. If you'd prefer a picnic, you're welcome to bring your own food and eat at one of the benches overlooking the scenic Swan Lake. Just don't feed any sandwiches to the animals!
